

Forklift Carriage

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type tine carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is something like 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted tines could differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
